What Concern is it to us if Our Brethren do not Attend Church?

Saint John Chrysostom was asked the same question in the late 4th Century and offered the following reply:

"Now these remarks of mine are not so much directed to those who do not attend, as to you who do not bring them forward and do not rouse them from their idleness, and bring them to this table of salvation. I call to mind that on the festival days the multitudes assembled resemble the broad expanse of the sea, but now not even the smallest part of that multitude is gathered together here. Where are they now who oppress us with their presence on the feast days? It is clear that the absence of all the others is due not only to their own idleness, but also to your neglect. But what if they do not desire to come, you say. Make them desire it by your continual demand to attend, for if they see you insisting upon it they certainly will desire to come. For what profit is a lamp if it does not give light to him who sits in darkness and what profit is a Christian when he leads no one back to virtue? Do you not see doves which have been trained, how they hunt for others when they are let out? Let us also do this. For what kind of excuse shall we have, if irrational creatures are able to hunt for an animal of their own species, while we who have been honored with reason and so much wisdom, neglect this kind of pursuit? I exhort you with these words: Go each of you to the houses of your brethren, wait for them to come out, lay hold of them, and bring them here. Now reach out as never before, rouse yourselves up, and let each person enter the Church accompanied by a member of his family: let them incite and urge on another to the assembly here, the father his son, the son his father, the husbands their wives and the wives their husbands, brother his brother and friend his friend; or rather let us not summon friends only but also enemies to this common treasury of good things. If thy enemy sees you care for his welfare, he will undoubtedly relinquish his hatred."

SUNDAY SCHOOL REGULATIONS

CLASSES: The minimum enrollment age is three years. These children are placed in the pre-school class. Children must have their third birthday by September 26th of the current year. All classes are set up solely according to the grade levels as in Public Schools.

TERM: The Sunday School term begins on September 26th, 2010 and extends through the second Sunday of June of the following year.

FEE: The children are asked to pay a nominal registration fee of:

One Child..... \$30.00
Two Children..... \$50.00
Three Children..... \$60.00

and to make weekly offerings. These contributions help pay a small portion of our Sunday School budget and most important, cultivate the Christian idea of stewardship to the children.

ATTENDANCE:

An attendance award will be given to those children who do not miss more than 3 Sundays during the school term. When a child attends another Greek Orthodox Church, he/she must bring a note from the Church School indicating his/her attendance. Each student is expected to attend classes every Sunday. (Illness is not an excused absence.)

HOURS: Sunday School begins 10:00 a.m. SHARP. Students and Teachers, excluding Nursery and Kindergarten, must be in Church for the Divine Liturgy by 9:45 a.m. the latest. The Divine Liturgy ends at 11:30 a.m. Any child arriving after 10:10 a.m. will be marked "tardy." Four (4) tardiness' will constitute an absence. Nursery and Kindergarten Teachers and Students must be in Church at 9:45 a.m. ONLY on the 1st Sunday of each month.

Each grade will attend the Divine Liturgy in its entirety once a month according to the following schedule:

1st Sunday of each month 1st, 2nd & 9th&10th Grades
2nd Sunday of each month 3rd, 4th, 11th & 12th Grades
3rd Sunday of each month 5th & 6th Grades
4th Sunday of each month 7th & 8th Grades
5th Sunday 9th - 12th Grades

ASSISTANTS:

Assistants are selected by Father Nick and must be High School Seniors, registered in the Sunday School Program, provided there is an open position. There will be no exception to this rule.

ALTAR BOYS:

Any Sunday School student 10 years or older, wishing to serve as an Altar Boy must contact Father Nick. They must also be registered in the Sunday School Program.
